- Instituted a cross training policy that encompassed BCC staff resources that were allocated to the project in a full or part role, but were not being well used or cross trained.
- Asked to assume leadership over the Clinical Order Sets Team and Clinical Trials efforts, in addition to the Oncology Team.
- Oncology work was placed on hold and the majority of the team released due to COVID-19 and closed international borders; CST project work was reprioritized to only those facilities that had al-ready activated (Keep the Lights On or KTLO).
